**CAFOD SOWING THE SEEDS OF POVERTY:**—Cafod's campaign is based on their latest report which shows how the World Bank is damaging local seed systems by forcing low-income countries to subsidise commercial seeds from big companies. This approach has done very little to address the needs of small scale farmers that the World Bank is supposed to be helping. Instead, it has meant that public funds have been transferred from low income countries into the pockets of big business.
