Unfortunately she could only come to Holyhead for the Lenten Lunch, but wanted to thank all the people in the various communities on Anglesey for the generosity of spirit and the monetary contributions given to CAFOD, not just this Lent, but over many years. Our Island has a proud reputation for supporting and giving generously to this charity. CAFOD's **Big Lenten Walk** in England and Wales kicked off on Ash Wednesday, with thousands of individuals, schools and parishes signing up to walk 200 kilometres during Lent and raising sponsorship money to help people tackling extreme poverty globally. More than 100,000 schoolchildren from more than 400 schools are taking part and more than 100 parish groups are signed up. In Holyhead there is *the Little Lenten Walk* organised by Paige Hudson Jones who is urging people to sign sponsorship money will be used wisely toward helping those less fortunate. The Walk takes place on Saturday 16th March.
