<u>"THE HOLY LAND AND US"</u>. On BBC2 television last Wednesday at 9pm and also next Wednesday (also available on iPlayer,) was a documentary exploring the personal stories of families of Jewish and Palestinian heritage - and the ways in which they have been defined by events in those two countries. This year marks 75 years since the State of Israel was founded. For Jews across the world, this represented a longed-for opportunity to find a place of safety. For Palestinians the events of this period, which created over 700,000 refugees and resulted in hundreds of towns and villages being destroyed, are known as the Nakba, Arabic for Catastrophe. This tv series gets to the heart of what happened to people on both sides of the conflict as the Middle East was shaped.
