UPDATE ABOUT FR FRANK

Fr Frank was admitted to Ysbyty Gwynedd on Tuesday 7th November. Two days before he had celebrated Mass as usual in Holyhead with no indication of any medical issues. But on the Monday and then on the Tuesday pain in his leg became so bad that he could not walk – even with assistance. His right knee, shin and foot were very badly swollen and very red. He was taken to A+E and admitted very quickly.

In hospital they extracted two phials of a liquid from under his knee and decided it was some form of infection which had appeared very quickly and then spread down the leg. They could not decide where the infection came from or how long it had been dormant before becoming very active and very infectious.

The next day, Wednesday 8th November, under general anaesthetic, the knee was opened up to reveal a mass of infection. This was "washed out" with antibiotics and closed up. An antibiotic drip was given twice a day to try to flush out any remaining infection. There was also the danger of blood clots in the veins. However, as the days went by, it did not improve. It was also increasingly difficulty for Fr Frank to move around due to the pain in the joint of the knee and also the inability to support himself on the infected leg.

The antibiotic infusion was changed to a much stronger one and to be applied once per day. After many days of infusions, injections for blood clots, and blood being taken away for analysis it would appear that the infection is slowly receding - even if the outward symptoms of redness and swelling are still very much present. The medical team are confident that they are now on top of the situation although there may be a long way to go - especially with the need for physiotherapy to help restore proper movement to the joints. A big word of thanks to all at Ogwen Ward who are caring for Fr Frank, doing a wonderful ministry and very friendly with it.
