THIS WEEKEND WE WELCOME Fr Vimal OMI to Anglesey. He is resident in the Oblate Parish in Colwyn Bay and will be here for Palm Sunday and the Services during Holy Week and Easter. Fr Vimal will be celebrating the Holy Week Liturgy in the different Churches across Anglesey during this week so we will all have a chance to welcome him. He is from Sri Lanka and has ministered in Sicily in past years.

HOLY WEEK begins today with Palm Sunday. It is the most solemn week of our Christian calendar leading us through Holy Thursday and Good Friday to the Great Easter Vigil. Will you be part of it? Will you plan your days/evenings so that you can spend time with the Lord in the special services. As we enter Holy Week we follow Christ's final days: his journey into Jerusalem today when he is hailed as "King", His betrayal on Wednesday by Judas for 30 pieces of silver, His Last Supper on Thursday when he said "Do this in memory of me...", His brutal death on the Friday called "Good", the quiet dead day of the Saturday in the tomb. All leading to the wondrous glory of the Resurrection at the Easter Vigil and on Easter Day.

CONFIRMATION PREPARATION 2022: The Island online Confirmation Preparation Programme “Empower” will begin after Easter on Tuesday evenings at 7pm. THE UKRAINE CRISIS - Mary Rowlands our Safeguarding Officer in the Wrexham Diocese has sent us the following message “After seeing the awful, desperate situation with the war in Ukraine, I am sure that many of you want to do something to help. Refugees and Asylum seekers often arrive in Wales not only following this traumatic experience in their country but also experiencing trauma on their journey to the UK. The Welsh Government want to ensure that these individuals are supported to rebuild their lives and make a full contribution to Welsh society. If you feel that you wanted to contribute or help with a family then more information can be found on refugees@gov.wales also : **CSAN (Caritas Social Action Network) Ukraine Toolkit** Bishop Kenneth Nowakowski updated the CBCEW (Catholic Bishops Conference of England and Wales) last week on the current situation in Ukraine and the support being offered in this country to displaced Ukrainians who are travelling from the war zone. Below is a link to the CSAN Ukraine Toolkit. This will be continually updated as more information is released by HM Government and other agencies regarding the support of Ukrainians arriving in this country. One key piece of advice to parishioners who are applying to host is to link with an organisation with refugee experience. The other main piece of advice is the decision by CSAN to focus on the Reset ‘matching’ service as the one to go to for people who wish to host, and indeed for Ukrainian people to register. There are a few options, but CSAN has decided to back Reset, with its experience of community sponsorship and knowledge in the field.
