Easter Triduum: The term triduum means 'three days.' The three days are counted as the Hebrews counted their days, from dusk to dusk. Therefore, the three days of the Easter

different part of the story of Jesus' saving action. We look at the Easter Triduum as one single celebration that lasts for three days. We cannot separate the death of Jesus from his resurrection. We do not spend all of the three days in church, but at various times during those days, we are called to church to gather and remember together. Because the Triduum tells an ongoing story, try if you can to make all the services.

MARRIAGE CARE: Marriage Care are pleased to offer a *Preparing Together* course for those preparing to get married in the Catholic Church this year. If couples are in a situation where this fee is unaffordable, they can contact the Marriage Care booking service on **0800 389 3801 Mon – Thurs (9 am–6 pm)** who will, without judgment, book their place and reduce or waive the fee altogether. WALK OF WITNESS. The Good Friday (this Friday) Walk of Witness takes place in our various parish areas. In Holyhead it starts by assembling in St Mary's Church for 12 noon. After a short introduction and prayer the procession makes it's way along Market Street to the Millennium Cross where prayers are said and hymns are sung. This is organised by Cytûn (Churches Together) and most religious denominations take part. Sadly, each Good Friday, the Catholic Church is usually the least represented in giving witness at this walk.
