BEAUMARIS - LLANGEFNI

WALK OF WITNESS (BEAUMARIS): The walk will stop at appropriate points to hear Gospel extracts and prayers reflecting the journey to Calvary. On Good Friday at 10am inside St Mary's then out into St Mary's garden, on to the gaol, Capel Y Drindod, Oasis, Our Lady's Queen of Martyrs BEAUMARIS before we move on to the Courthouse and then Mount Field. At 2pm there will be an ecumenical service at Oasis to which all are invited with a special encouragement to those who cannot manage the walk as this service will follow the same format but seated.
