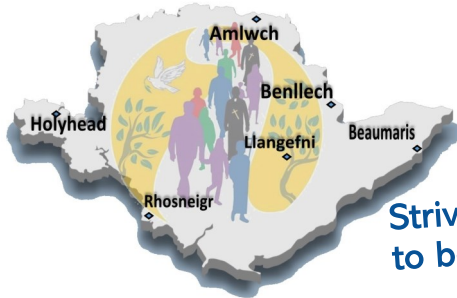

BEAUMARIS - LLANGFNFI

WALK OF WITNESS (BEAUMARIS): The walk will stop at appropriate points to hear Gospel extracts and prayers reflecting the journey to Calvary. On **Good Friday at 10am** inside St Mary's then out into St Mary's garden, on to the gaol, Capel Y Drindod, Oasis, Our Lady's Queen of Martyrs BEAUMARIS before we move on to the Courthouse and then Mount Field. At 2pm there will be an ecumenical service at Oasis to which all are invited with a special encouragement to those who cannot manage the walk as this service will follow the same format but seated.

GROWING IN POTS: St Joseph's Church, Llangefni **Thursday 4th April 11am** following 10am Service. Novices and experienced growers of salad and vegetables are welcome to join the group.

SOCIAL OUTING TO PLAS CADANT - **Sunday 14th April** organised by BEAUMARIS - LLANGFNFI Social Committee. Arrival at 1pm. **Parishioners from all of the island parishes are most welcome**.
