THE "REPAIR AND RENOVATION OF WOODWORK FUND "HAS BEGUN! St Mary's Parish (Holyhead) Centre, Oratory and House was built in 1993—thirty years ago. The woodwork all around this complex is in need of renovation and repair. Work has been done over the years, but now is the time for a professional job to be done. This will be costly, and to this end a Fund for this work has been set up. Any fundraising (Teas + Coffees on Sunday, a December concert by Holyhead Male Voice Choir, and any other fundraising donations) will be put toward this work. The overall cost of the project has not been estimated - when it is you will be informed. The fund has begun with the proceeds of last weeks teas and coffees in St Mary's£41.30 and £9.05 from the bric a brac table in the Hall. Small beginnings indeed, but, remember the parable of the mustard seed from our New Testament and how large it grew from very small beginnings! POPE FRANCIS' PRAYER INTENTION FOR OCTOBER 2023 This month Pope Francis reminds us of the gift of being a good listener. Good listening isn't just about sitting quietly, hearing, and then saying what we were going to say anyhow! Being a good listener isn't about making the right noises and dishing out our own 'good advice'. A good listener understands the person who is speaking and feels how the speaker is feeling. This month Pope Francis asks us to join in his prayer intention for Oct "That that the Church may adopt listening and dialogue as a style of life at every level, allowing herself to be guided by the Holy Spirit towards the world's peripheries" SETTING UP A STANDING ORDER. Have you considered setting up a standing order for the weekly contribution you make by way of the Offertory Collection at Mass? It is simple and confidential and can be done very easily. By contributing in this way it ensures that your contribution arrives into the parish funds each week or month (or whatever you desire), which helps contribute to stable financial management. During the Covid epidemic a number of parishioners set up a standing order for which we are extremely grateful. It is also possible to Gift Aid this contribution if you are a tax payer. Gift aiding means that 25% of your donation is returned by the Government into the parish accounts. This can be a considerable sum of money depending on the amount of Gift Aiders. Please consider it seriously, and, if more information is required, get in
