SUNDAY NOVEMBER 12th REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY.

In past years when the Sunday morning Mass in Holyhead was at 11am, the time would be changed to 11.15am to allow people to attend the ceremony at the Cenotaph at 11am. Due to a change in time of the Mass in Holyhead to 10.30am it was decided to change this Mass time to 10am to allow people to attend The Service of Remembrance at the Cenotaph at 11am. Otherwise the two Services would overlap and clash. It is hoped this earlier time, on a one off occasion, will not prove a difficulty for many parishioners.

THE LAST MASS IN ST ANNE'S CHURCH MENAI BRIDGE was celebrated on Thursday 5th October at 6pm. The principal celebrant was our Bishop, Peter Brignall, along with the Oblate Provincial Fr Oliver Barry. Also present were Fr Francis Arinze Ayogu from Pwllheli, Fr Joe and Fr Frank. There were about 25 persons in the congregation. Jean McQueen welcomed us all. Bp Peter spoke about the history of the Church, the priests who had served in past years, and the feelings of sadness that it was now time to close it. Before the end of the Mass he went to key places in the Church: the Baptistry - to give thanks for all who were received into the faith at this font; to the Confessional - for the people who had expressed their sorry and received forgiveness through the Sacrament of Penance; to the lectern - for the many people who had listened to the Word of God proclaimed there; to the Altar - remembering the many people who had received their 1st Holy Communion at the sanctuary, and the multitudes who partook of the Body of Christ in Holy Communion at this place over the many years. The stained glass windows were acknowledged as reminding us of the Saints whose courage and example we emulate.

HOLYHEAD CENOTAPH CENTENARY RE-DEDCATION CEREMONY will take place on Tuesday 7th November at 5pm. The ceremony is to commemorate the 100 years that have passed since it was first unveiled in Victoria Square in 1923 as a memorial to those who lost their lives in the First World War. Details will follow about the programme of Events closer to the time.

EUGENE DE MAZENOD 101: This course is about the life and spirituality of St. Eugene de Mazenod, founder of the Missionary Oblates of Mary Immaculate, who also inspired the formation of a charism family of laity around the world. It is a non-academic enrichment course for those seeking to grow in their knowledge and understanding of the life, charism, spirituality and mission of St. Eugene. The course consists of 16 short videos with additional supplementary material for each video. The aim of this course is:

- 2/ To assist you to understand the charism, mission, and spirituality of St. Eugene de Mazenod.
- 3/ To see in him and his Mazenodian spirituality as a model of holiness that can enrich your life.
- 4/ For members of the Mazenodian Family to be inspired to discover their individual vocation.

The course will be divided into 16 sessions, **beginning on Friday November 3rd, 11am via Zoom**Each session will include a video of around 20 minutes.
