when the Holy Father invites all Catholics to contribute to a special collection for MISSIO, his charity for World Mission. There is a 2nd collection at each of the Churches on the **Island.** Annually, on the penultimate Sunday of October, Mission Sunday is celebrated in every parish around the world. On this day the Universal Catholic Church joins together, through prayer and sharing, in support of dioceses and parishes too poor or young to support themselves. It is not easy in today's present financial climate to have spare money to donate but please give what you can. SUNDAY NOVEMBER 12th REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY.

In past years when the Sunday morning Mass in Holyhead was at 11am, the time would be changed to 11.15am to allow people to attend the ceremony at the Cenotaph at 11am. Due to a change in time of the Mass in Holyhead to 10.30am it was decided to change this Mass time to 10am to allow people to attend The Service of Remembrance at the Cenotaph at 11am.

<u>OVER THE PAST FEW YEARS</u> the Faith Community in Amlwch have changed the time of their Saturday evening Mass whenever the clocks go back- and it is darker earlier in the evening. The Rhosneigr Faith Community have decided to do the same for their Saturday evening Mass.

The times of these Masses will change on Saturday 4th November.

Amlwch will change from 5pm to 4pm and Rhosneigr from 6pm to 5pm.

HOLYHEAD CENOTAPH CENTENARY RE-DEDICATION CEREMONY will take place on Tuesday 7th November at 5pm. It will start with a Candlelight parade from St Cybi's Church through Holyhead town to the Cenotaph. This will be led by Sea Cadets, Scouts, Guides and school children. The ceremony is to commemorate the 100 years that have passed since it was first unveiled in Victoria Square in 1923 as a memorial to those who lost their lives in the First World War.

<u>FUNERAL MINISTERS AND BEREAVEMENT VISITORS SUPPORT SESSION</u>: Thursday 26th October 11am at Our Lady of Lourdes Church Benllech.

EUGENE DE MAZENOD 101: This course is about the life and spirituality of St. Eugene de Mazenod, founder of the Missionary Oblates of Mary Immaculate, who also inspired the formation of a charism family of laity around the world. It is a non-academic enrichment course for those seeking to grow in their knowledge and understanding of the life, charism, spirituality and mission of St. Eugene. The course consists of 16 short videos with additional supplementary material for each video. The aim of this course is:

- 1/ To help you to gain a deeper knowledge of the life of St. Eugene de Mazenod.
- 2/ To assist you to understand the charism, mission, and spirituality of St. Eugene de Mazenod.
- 3/ To see in him and his Mazenodian spirituality as a model of holiness that can enrich your life.
- 4/ For members of the Mazenodian Family to be inspired to discover their individual vocation.

The course will be divided into 16 sessions, beginning on Friday November 3rd, 11am via Zoom Each session will include a video of around 20 minutes.
