Fr Frank was admitted to Ysbyty Gwynedd on Tuesday 7th November. He continues to be treated in hospital for a severe infection in his knee. Thankfully this week there has been some small progress towards recovery and Fr Frank has been able to mobilise without assistance for the first time since he was admitted to hospital. The physiotherapy team are very pleased with his willingness and determination to get back on his feet which will help to reduce the amount of time that he will need to be treated in the hospital setting. Fr Frank is hoping that it will not be too long before the medical team will be satisfied that the infection has receded enough for him to continue his treatment in a community setting. However he has been advised that even after he is discharged from hospital he will need a long period of convalescence to assist his recovery. It will be some time yet before he rejoins the football team ! Fr Frank is very grateful for all the support, prayers and good wishes that he is receiving.
